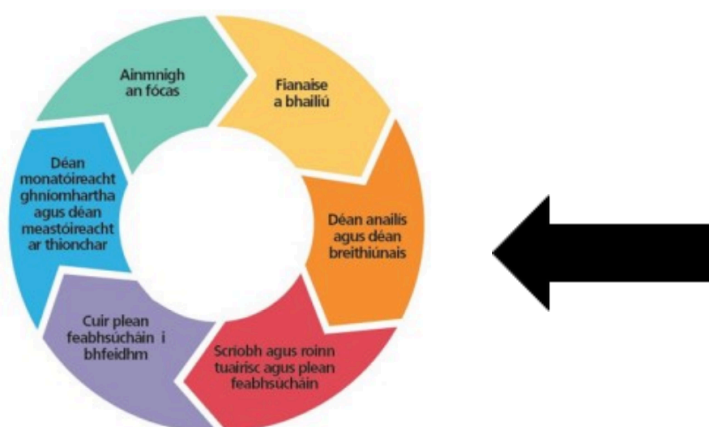
Féinmheastóireacht scoile/ School Self Evaluation

Cad is féinmheastóireacht scoile ann?

An rud atá i gceist le féinmheastóireacht scoile (FMS) ná próiseas comhoibríoch, athmhachnamhach agus cuimsitheach den athbhreithniú inmheánach scoile. Le linn FMS, beidh foireann na scoile, faoi stiúir an bhoird bhainistíochta agus an phátrúin, agus i gcomhairle leis na tuismitheoirí agus leis na daltaí, páirteach i bhfiosrú athmhachnamhach ar obair na scoile. Baineann féinmheastóireacht scoile go príomha le feabhsúchán agus le forbairt scoile.

Cá bhfuil GSBB sa phróiseas Féinmheastóireacht scoile (FMS)?

Faoi láthair táimid ar chéim 3 ‘Déan anailís agus breithiúnais’. Míle buíochas daoibh siúd a líon an suirbhé bunaithe ar chúrsaí folláine isteach. Roinneadh suirbhé leis an bhfoireann agus na páistí i R3-6 freisin. Rinneadh ceistneoir le fócasghrúpaí ó Naíonáin bheaga – Rang 2 agus an Cuan Sinsearach. Roimh dheireadh na scoilbliana beidh muid ar chéim 4 ‘Scríobh agus roinn tuairisc agus plean feabhsúcháin’.

What is school self evaluation?

School self-evaluation (SSE) is a collaborative, reflective and comprehensive process of internal school review. During SSE, the school staff, under the direction of the board of management and the patron, and in consultation with the parents and the pupils, will be involved in a reflective inquiry into the work of the school. School self-evaluation is primarily concerned with school improvement and development.

What stage is GSBB at in SSE?

We are currently at step 3 'Analyse and make judgements'. Many thanks to those of you who completed the survey based on wellbeing. We also shared surveys with the staff and pupils in 3rd to 6th class. Questionnaires were completed with focus groups from Junior Infants to 2nd class and the Senior Cuan. By the end of the school year, we will be on step 4 'Write and share report and improvement plan'.

- Oideachas Sóisialta agus Imshaoil (Stair agus Tíreolaíocht)
- Folláine (Corpoideachas agus Oideachas Sóisialta, Pearsanta agus Sláinte)

- **Modern Foreign Languages, as part of the Primary Language Curriculum**
- **Science, Technology and Engineering Education**
- **Social and Environmental Education (History and Geography)**
- **Wellbeing (Physical Education and Social, Personal and Health Education).**

You can have your say by completing the online questionnaire for parent/guardians, or by completing a written submission. Follow the SunSmart 5 S's to reduce your risk of skin cancer



Slip on clothing that covers your skin



Slop on sunscreen on exposed areas using factor 30+ for adults and 50+ for children



Slap on a wide-brimmed hat



Seek shade – especially if outdoors between 11am and 3pm



Slide on sunglasses

Do not deliberately try to get a suntan. Avoid getting a sunburn. Never use a sunbed.

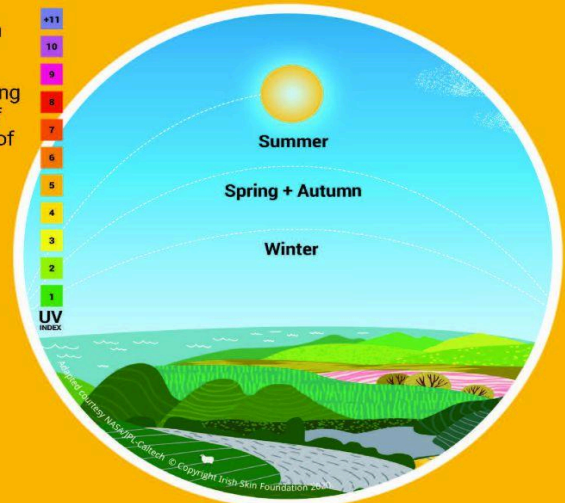

Playing outdoors: Skin protection for children

Playing and spending time outdoors is good for your child. But it is important to protect their skin when outside in the sun.

- Ultraviolet radiation (UV) is a part of sunlight. It can damage skin and increase risk of skin cancer.
- Children's skin is very sensitive to UV from the sun. Sunburn during childhood increases the risk of getting skin cancer as an adult. If your child is badly sunburned more than 3 times before the age of 20, they more than double their risk of skin cancer as an adult.
- In Ireland, UV from the sun is strongest from April to September between 11am-3pm, even when it is cloudy.
- **Protect yourself and children by being SunSmart as part your daily routine from April – September.**



SunSmart simple steps can protect children's skin and avoid getting sunburn: **Remember the SunSmart 5 'Ss'**, even when it is cloudy

- For children up to 1 year old, it is best to keep them in the shade and wear clothing that covers their skin when outdoors.
- It is better to protect babies up to 6 months old from sunlight by using shade and clothing rather than sunscreen. You may choose to use sunscreen sometimes on small parts of baby's skin. If you do, choose a sunscreen that is for babies such as sensitive or toddler sunscreen.



Slip on clothing: Cover skin as much as possible e.g. wear long sleeves, collared t-shirts, clothes made from close-woven material that does not allow sunlight through.



Slop on broad-spectrum (UVA/UVB) sunscreen with a sun protection factor (SPF) of at least 30+ for adults and 50+ for children, with high UVA protection, and water resistant. Reapply regularly.



Slap on a hat with a wide brim: Protect your face, ears and neck.



Seek shade: Sit in cover of trees to avoid direct sunlight and use a sunshade on your buggy or pram. Keep babies and children out of direct sunlight.



Slide on sunglasses with UV protection: Guard your eyes from harm.
