Leanfaidh Scéim na leabhar bunscoile saor in aisce arís i mbliana. Faoin scéim seo, cuirfear leabhair, leabhair oibre agus cóipleabhair ar fáil saor in aisce do dhaltaí. Anuraidh, bhíomar in ann roinnt mhaith de na costais breise a sheasamh. Faraor, ní beimid in ann é seo a dhéanamh arís don bhliain seo chugainn, cé go mbeidh fordheonú ann fós.

Rachaidh bille €45 an páiste ar Aladdin. Rachaidh an t-airgead seo i dtreo árachas, fearas ealaíne, costais cóipeála, fearas ranga, sintús bliantiúil IXL, Seesaw srl agus stáisinéireacht. This year sees the continuation of the Government's Free School Books Scheme. This scheme allows for free textbooks, workbooks and copy books for all primary school children. We were lucky last year to be in a position to stand the cost of additional expenses. However, we cannot absorb the full cost of this again this year. Although still subsidised, there will be an increase in the school bill for each child. A payment of €45 per child will go on Aladdin. This payment will go towards student insurance, art supplies, photocopying costs, classroom equipment, annual subscriptions such as IXL & Seesaw and stationery.

Please ensure that your child retains any atlas, dictionaries, calculators etc for use next year and leaves them in school at the end of this term.
